














Small Loop	Directions	Prayer Points
	<p>Start at the St Clement's Centre. Head out of the onto cross street and turn left. Walk up to Morrell Avenue.</p>	<p>The Centre hosts many different groups like Toddlers, Pilates, and Scouts. Pray for all those in our community who use this building.</p>
	<p>Turn left on to Morrell Avenue and walk towards St Clement's Street. Can you find the 4 pubs along the street?</p>	<p>There are many restaurants, cafes and pubs along St Clement's Street. Pray for all these businesses as they open again for business.</p>
	<p>Cross Rectory Road to remain on St Clement's Street</p>	<p>Abbey field is one of the many Supported Housing in St Clement's Parish. Pray for all those in supported housing, especially those who have been unable to see loved ones during this time, and all in the parish who feel alone.</p>
	<p>Cross Jeune Street and pause to look across to Boulter Street.</p>	<p>On the corner of Boulter Street you will see The Mish. Pray for all those who live or work at The Mish. Pray for The Living Room which will be opening soon to support the homeless.</p>
	<p>Follow the pavement around the roundabout and up Cowley Road. Can you find the information point about St Clement's Church?</p>	<p>The site of the roundabout is where St Clement's Church was originally. Take this opportunity to pray for all who belong to St Clement's Church.</p>
	<p>Cross Tyndale Road to stay on Cowley Road. Can you see the bright welcome sign?</p>	<p>There are many businesses along Cowley Road. Pray for those that have had to close and for those now reopening.</p>

	<p>Cross Alma Place to stay on Cowley Road</p>	<p>On the corner of Alma Place is Oxford Chabat Society who support Jewish students. Pray for inter faith relationships and communities.</p>
	<p>Cross Jeune Street to Stay on Cowley Road.</p>	<p>The Oxford Baby Bank runs at the Methodist Church. Pray for the families in our parish who are struggling.</p>
	<p>Cross Rectory Road to Stay on Cowley Road.</p>	<p>The Rectory Centre provides a variety of health services. Pray for those who need extra support in the Parish.</p>
	<p>How many lions are on the gates of Oriel College?</p>	<p>Oriel College is opposite. Pray for all students studying at both the Oxford Universities.</p>
	<p>Cross Princess Street to Stay on Cowley Road and then turn left down Union Street. Can you find the large mural somewhere on Union Street?</p>	<p>East Oxford Primary School and the East Oxford Lifelong Learning Centre are halfway down Union Street. Pray for all the students and staff. Especially students who have missed out on exams or had to transition at this difficult time.</p>
	<p>At the bottom of Union Street turn left on to Morrell Avenue.</p>	<p>Take the opportunity to pray for and bless those people and their families who live here.</p>
	<p>Take the next left onto Cross Street and return to St Clement's Centre.</p>	<p>As you head back to the St Clement's Centre remember the charities that work out of this building. KEEN – works to make Oxford a more inclusive city for everyone. CAP - provides free debt help, provides practical and emotional support to show people that there is always hope. Charity of Thomas Dawson – Supports charitable and educational projects in the area. Parish Property Trust – Supports the “spiritual, intellectual, moral or social wants” of the parishioners of St Clement's Parish.</p>
